Her training also included extensive internship experience at a number of recognized institutions in the greater Boston area, including Brandeis University and McLean Hospital, a teaching facility of the Harvard Medical School. Dr. Karol also completed an internship year at the Jimmy Fund Clinic, a renowned treatment and research center at Boston's Dana-Farber Cancer Institute. There, she worked with children suffering from life threatening illnesses, and their families.
